Parent Teacher Interviews

Morning Supervision

There are children being dropped to school far too early in the morning. Supervision does not begin till 8.15am. If you do drop your children too early to school, we will have to call you to come back to collect them or stay with them till 8.15am.

School Opal Card

The School Opal card gives eligible students free travel between home and school. The local bus services have indicated some students are travelling on school buses without a valid Opal card. All students eligible for an Opal card need to tap on and off as services will appear underutilised and may be considered for cancellation based on low passenger numbers. Students who are ineligible for a School Opal card need to purchase a Child/Youth Opal card or pay cash fare to travel on the bus.
