### **Canberra Excursion**

Last week the Year 6 students travelled to Canberra to consolidate their learning about Government and Civics. We had a very busy three days, visiting the National Capital Exhibition, Australian War Memorial, National Dinosaur Museum, Australian Institute of Sport, Deep Space Communication Complex, Australian Parliament House, Questacon, National Electoral Education Centre and the Museum of Australian Democracy. The students' behaviour and manners were commendable and they reflected an extensive knowledge over the three days.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit their National Capital as part of their civics and citizenship education. To assist with the payment of the excursion, the Australian Government contributed funding of \$20 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program. We would like to thank the Australian Government for their support of this program and we hope that this excursion was a rewarding experience for all students.

Thank you to the teachers and parent who accompanied the students on this excursion: Mr Lynch, Mrs Jones and Mr Laing. I felt really privileged to spend the three days getting to know this beautiful group of children.

123 Magic and Emotion Coaching is a program designed to teach parents ways to manage their children's behaviour that also builds their children's emotional resourcefulness.


All are invited to participate in this valuable workshop which will run over three consecutive Fridays, 14th, 21st and 28th June at 9am.
