School Uniform

Uniform: It is lovely to see our children so well presented in the St Cecilia's School uniform. It is a lovely uniform and it is a great representation of our school. Just a gentle reminder that it is important for our children to wear the correct uniform including the correct socks. Sports socks should be plain white and not have any logos on them.

Shoes: While children can wear any colour or style of jogger on sports day, they must wear black leather style shoes with their regular school uniform. I do understand there are a variety of black jogger style shoes but these are not appropriate for the school uniform.

Hair: All children, including boys, with hair longer than shoulder length should have it tied back. Nits are always a problem in school and this rule is to help reduce the risk of your child getting them.

Jewellery: We have noticed an increase in the number of children wearing necklaces and other pieces of jewellery. These pieces are beautiful and often have sentimental value attached to them. We have, on several occasions, had very upset children because they have lost their jewellery, this is one of the reasons children are not allowed to wear them to school. We also don't allow jewellery for WHS reasons. During play and sport, necklaces and other pieces of jewellery can get caught and cause injury.
