We ask the children to dress as a farmer and donate as little or as much as you are able. We will then use the donation to give the family a credit in a local store. The idea is that two families are then supported.

Apologies for the lack in communication we've been so busy these last few months. We finally had a good lambing and only had 1 poddy lamb this year, last year I had 8, we finally got to see harvest after 3 years, the kids were so excited to see the headers going around and the silos and pits being filled. The hay shed is full as well!!!

Matthew's parents are going well, and we've been lucky to have many of our cows get in calf and have calf's this year. We are still building our numbers, but current prices aren't helping too much so holding on until prices are more favourable for us to afford buying again.

We haven't had much rain the last 2 months so things have dried off somewhat, but we still have plenty of dry feed but some rain for Christmas would be nice. The main dam that supplies the water to our town is at 45% so we still need more rain to have things completely back to normal.

We still so thankful for everything you did for us and our hearts $\ \ \ \ \$ are so full knowing that your students, parents and teachers did so much for us when we were at our lowest.

I have attached a few photos of our new poddy calves, we are currently have 6, and this sometimes happens with new mothers and the cattle just not able to look after their calves.
