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

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

### **QKR!** Online ordering

I am aware that there have been issues for some people trying to place lunch orders on the QKR! App.

The main reason for ordering difficulty is the time/traffic issue. Please try to place orders outside of peak ordering times. Internet traffic is extremely high around 7.30am to 8.30am on the day of canteen, so ordering the night before or day before is strongly encouraged to avoid disappointment.

### **Cut Off Time**

All schools have an ordering cut off time. This is necessary so orders can be tallied, stickers printed, and canteen operations can get underway in an efficient and timely manner to ensure lunch orders are delivered on time. The cut off time at St Cecilia's is 8.30am on Wednesday and Friday.

No lunch orders will be taken over the phone.


