## **Accessibility to The Oval**

On Friday afternoon I received telephone advice that the bulk of the oval could be reopened for normal access, except for a strip along the eastern side, immediately next to the concrete path.

Unfortunately, the most recent testing of the oval had still returned very moderate results along that eastern edge of the school oval. Further testing will be taken again this week and hopefully the final area will be released as soon as we receive negative results.

Despite some fencing still prohibiting full access to the oval, the children were thrilled to regain majority of their grass area back to play on today. I would like to commend the children for being incredibly patient and adaptable with the limited space they have had in the playground during this lengthy restoration period of our playground. We were fortunate enough to regain access at a faster pace to the multipurpose room, however the oval circumstances proved to be slightly more challenging. Hopefully by next term we will have full access to the oval.

## **Pick Up and Drop Off Procedures**

Earlier in the week I sent out a gentle reminder of the pick-up and drop off procedures. I wanted to say thank you for everyone's prompt attention and cooperation with this matter. Parents have been waiting under the hall and walking past the class lines when collecting their child/ren and the pickup appears to be a lot more orderly and children departing at the right time and safely with their rightful parent or carer at the end of each day.

To assist in the methodical system of collection, as of tomorrow we will no longer stagger pick-ups and have all children from Kindergarten to Year Six collected at 3:05pm, from under the hall ONLY.

Furthermore, as Parent/Teacher interviews are happening this week, teachers will be rushing off for scheduled meeting times from 3:15pm in the afternoon, and they will be in morning meetings from 8am. Therefore, I wanted to clarify the pick-up and drop off procedures below and reiterate school hours, when teachers are on **supervision duties are ONLY from 8:15am – 3:15pm.**
