Dear Parents and Carers,

This Sunday is the start of Advent - the time of waiting and preparing. It is a busy time at school, with planning and preparations for 2022 well underway. All staff are currently editing student reports, considering next year's class lists and structures, planning transition and handovers, preparing for end of year events, as well as the new school year!

It is usually a busy time at best but this year it seems even busier and possibly made harder by the feeling that time has somehow been taken away from us and now we try extremely hard to condense all our normal end of year activities into a shorter period. Let us all remember to pause, breathe and know that all things will happen during this time of waiting and preparation, and not to put added pressure on ourselves. This term is a time to celebrate being together after being separated for so long during lockdown.

Classes for 2022 & Step-Up Morning

When planning for 2022 classes, current teachers consult carefully and consider all relevant data in making the decisions about class placements for grades next year. Factors considered include; PBL data, academic, social, and emotional needs and of course class dynamics. Children also have a voice and have all completed a sociogram which will also be taken into account.

Teachers never rush these decisions, and many factors are considered. Overwhelmingly, the changes are positive and the mix up into a new cohort is a wonderful experience, encouraging resilience and the making of new bonds and new friendships. The two classes in each grade still often come together throughout the year and have many opportunities to work as one.

New classes and teachers will be announced in Week 11 with a 'Step Up' morning arranged for Tuesday 14th December.

<u>Year 4, 2022</u>

We are looking to grow our 2022, year 4 cohort, so if you know anyone interested in enrolling their current year 3 child into St Cecilia's, please encourage them to contact the school office to ENROL NOW! Our school is now a direct feeder into St Peter's Secondary College, Tuggerah so any child who graduates from St Cecilia's is assured a place into St Peter's.

We have received extra staffing allocation for next year's Year 4 cohort from Catholic Schools Broken Bay. I will provide further information to the parents of this cohort when staffing appointments are finalised.

Year 6 Leadership Elections

It is election time for the student leaders of 2022. These elections will also vary this year, as we still cannot have our whole school in one indoor, assembly space. The current year 5 children presented their speeches to Stage Three (years 5&6) this week for the first round of voting. The children with the most votes from ROUND 1, will then present their speech again to grades 2, 3 and 4 via Zoom in ROUND 2. *Year 5 parents will receive the Zoom link and are welcome to join us from home to listen to the speeches.* After all the speeches are presented voting from grades 2, 3 & 4 will take place. Teachers will vote too. Parents of voted in school captains will be confidentially notified by Mrs Chylewska to attend the end of year Mass in the role of badge presenter.

Fortnightly Awards Assembly - Change Of Date

As part of Wellbeing Week, Mr Lynch booked in an AFL clinic for the children this *Friday 26th November*. To ensure the AFL coaches maximise their time with the children, we would like to move the Fortnightly Awards Assembly from Friday to Monday 29th November. <u>Awards Ceremony</u>

After much deliberation, we have made the decision to cancel the End of Year Awards Ceremony for Kindergarten through to Year 5. We appreciate the significance of celebrating outstanding student achievement, however due to the interrupted year of COVID and with focus only on Literacy, Numeracy and RE during HBL and upon our return to school, it would be too difficult to accurately identify our deserving candidates for all subject areas as done in previous years.

Year 6 will be the only grade receiving the awards as it's their last year and they have been continuing with the teaching and learning of all subject areas, in preparation for high school. The year 6 Academic Achievement awards will be given out at Year 6 Graduation. Thank you for your understanding and support.

2:15pm - Year 5 and Year 6




