**Permission Notes:** Permission notes are sent home via Compass as an **Opt-in event**. If you are unable to access the permission form please email the front office who can supply you with a paper copy.

#### **TEACHING AND LEARNING**

210 new devices have arrived in our classrooms to start the school year!!!

At St Cecilia's we now have 1:1 Chromebooks in Years 5 & 6. 1:1 Ipads in Years 2, 3 & 4 and approximately 20 devices in each Kinder and Year 1 classrooms. These are school owned and managed devices and we believe we are preparing our students for now and the future through using these learning tools. Thank you to Mrs Sheppeard and Mrs Cumming for all the background work getting the devices into classrooms.







#### **BIRTHDAYS**

At St Cecilia's, we enjoy honouring children on their birthday. We also respect families that do not want us making a big deal out of their child's birthday. We enjoy many St Cecilia's traditions that go along with acknowledging birthdays. We announce the weekly birthday children at Monday morning's assembly, classes sing the "Happy Birthday" song, and families have always had the option of bringing in treats for classmates. Please know that you do not have to send treats or gifts with your child on his or her birthday. Teachers take great pride in making your child feel special on their birthday. If you do feel the need to send something for your child to enjoy with her or his classmates, please follow the birthday guidelines below:

- Foods made at home may not be distributed within the school.
- Any food item must be individually, commercially wrapped.
- Any food item must be NUT FREE.
- Please do not send cupcakes, doughnuts, or sheet cakes to cut up for your child's birthday treats. These items are not individually wrapped and will be sent back home.

If your child has any food allergies, could you please email the office to let the school know ASAP.
