ROAD SAFETY REMINDER

PARKING

A friendly reminder that we have several No Parking Zones around our school. Specifically, one near the back school gate and one opposite side the road from school, across from the school office building.

A No Parking Zone means that you must not stop for more than two minutes. You must remain in or within three metres of the vehicle. No Parking Zones are suitable for dropping off and picking up quickly.
