#### **School Closure**

Thank you so much for your understanding last week with the school closure during the Flood Evacuation Order. These orders are issued by the NSW SES to immediately evacuate at-risk sections of the community from a flood threatened area and advise the safest actions to take.

In consultation with the Wyong SES Unit and CSBB we had to comply with the order to ensure everyone's safety. Furthermore, after last year's flooding, and with this year's accessibility issues we weren't going to take any risks that could compromise people's safety. Thankfully our school did not flood and with a few consecutive days of warm sunshine, the mud bath on the oval will hopefully dry up soon.

#### Staff Development Day

The last day of term two, Friday 1st July will be a System Wide Staff Development Day. Please note this in your diary and make alternate care arrangements for your children. The school will not be open this day.

#### Signing Children In/Out

Now that parents are welcome back onsite, we will return to the regular procedures for late arrivals or early departures. If children are leaving school before 3:05pm, parents will need to come into the office to sign their child out at the Compass Kiosk in the front office foyer. Similarly, if a child arrives after 8:45am the parent or carer will need to sign the child in at the front foyer of the office.

#### Families Learning in Partnership (FLIP)



Over the past two years parental involvement and learning participation played a significant and positive role in the commitment of our learners towards remote learning during the COVID-19 lockdowns. We want to harness the strong parental involvement that has occurred the past two years and build even stronger parent-school partnerships. This will occur in the new formation of *Families Learning in Partnership* (FLIP).

A key objective for Catholic Schools Broken Bay (CSBB) Towards 2025 Strategy is to 'Strengthen family, school,

parish and diocesan relationships.' 
#### **Inquiry Based Learning**




St Cecilia's students are embarking on inquiry based learning across the school. Students learn through a cycle of inquiry:-
