Although I'm on leave this week, I always enjoy reminiscing over the term that has been and taking a moment to reflect on everything that has occurred. It's been a productive and enjoyable term three at St Cecilia's. Some of the highlights I pondered on from the past ten weeks include:

- Introduction of Shine Awards on Compass as acknowledgement for PBL behaviours exhibited by our children daily. All parents would receive email notification of these when your child has earned one.
- Launching Reading Buddies in the library every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. So grateful to Mrs Cumming for coordinating this opportunity for our Year 1 and Kindy children to practise reading their home reader to some of our older children in grades 4, 5 & 6.
- Our annual Grandparents Liturgy, Father's Day breakfast and Book Week Parade was hosted.
- Our annual Book Fair that raised over \$7000, which will go towards new Inquiry resources.
- Mrs Herd began her Gifted and Talented writing program with grades 3-6, putting together a school newsletter which has been forwarded to parents.
- 516 Mathematic Goals achieved across the whole school as part of our Numeracy Learning Improvement Program. Our children's personal mathematical goals have provided them with direction and clarity and have been great motivators, encouraging children to overcome barriers.
- The children took you on a journey of their school days through their school musical. They showcased their talents for one matinee and two evening shows each one attended exceptionally well with a packed hall throughout. The children and staff involved put in a huge number of hours over the last few months to bring you yet another fabulous musical production. With a never ending array of talent, catchy tunes and dances it proved to be a musical to remember for the whole community. Without all your support and the dedication of Mrs Whyte and Mrs Boler, it wouldn't be possible, so thank you.
- We welcomed our new canteen manager Mrs Nicholas who has taken the role in her stride.
- A successful trial of 40 minutes morning tea and 40 minutes lunch time break.
- Our first ever K-6 Public Speaking Competition took place and the talent was phenomenal!
   The competition saw many confident, clear and focused speakers, in a public situation. As we continue this event annually at St Cecilia's we hope to contribute to an improved self-esteem in our students in the world beyond school. Public Speaking is an integral part of the literacy program and part of every classroom's curriculum.
- We said goodbye to our coding teacher Grigory and welcome Henry Confos to help continue on our sophisticated level of Coding in grades 4-6.

- Extra curricula, GKR Karate lunch club began this term with a full class of 30 children attending their lessons in the hall every Thursday at lunch time.
- Year 3 were blessed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit through their Sacrament of Confirmation.
- Thanks to year 6, Mrs Lianna Jones and Mrs Clancy we were able to restart our Peer Support
   Program
- Reviewed the buddies format for 2023. Year 5 will be the buddies of Kindy Gold and Year 6 will be the buddies of Kindy Blue. Then from 2024 it will only be Year 5 who will be the Kindy Buddies.

Mrs Whyte, your three thirds of a smile will be long lasting and forever remembered because it meant so much to those who put it on your face, the children of St Cecilia's.


We send our prayers of gratitude to you Lord so that you can bless and provide love to our school community. Amen




#### **Sharing Our Fabulous Learning**

#### **NAPLAN Results**

A huge congratulations to our Year 3 and Year 5 students for their performance in the NAPLAN tests they sat earlier this year. This is the best overall result we have on record at St Cecilia's.

Our Year 5 students average scores were above or well above the similar schools average and the state average in all areas, numeracy, reading, writing, spelling, and grammar & punctuation.

Our Year 3 students average scores were above or well above the similar schools average and the state average in the areas of writing, spelling, and grammar & punctuation and above the similar school average in numeracy and reading.

#### **Mathematics Goals**

We are continuing our focus on improving the Place Value knowledge and skills in Mathematics. All our students are working towards individual Place Value Goals set at their current point of need. This term we have had students achieving 516 goals which includes many students achieving multiple goals.

This is a great effort from all the students and we will continue to monitor their progress next term.
