Your support allowed us to prioritise a thorough and deep clean of the school grounds and facilities, ensuring that our staff and children can safely return to a clean and welcoming environment.

Currently, we are still awaiting the results from the hygienist regarding soil testing on the oval. As a precaution, the oval will remain out of bounds until we have received the all-clear. In the meantime, we are also replenishing the bark and sandpit areas to ensure they are safe and enjoyable for the children to play once more.

We are fully aware of how trying and disruptive these situations can be—not only for our school, but also for many of our staff and families at home. Please know that you have all been in our thoughts and prayers throughout this time.
